OLD BUSINESS:

The Clerk brought up the turning of the Municipal Alliance over to shared services with Hope and White Township and recommended that we keep it in house. After discussion, motion was made by Mr. Kuhn, seconded by Mr. Desiderio to keep Municipal Alliance. All were in favor.

A quote for a charge of \$990.00 maximum was given by Darlene Green of Maser Consulting to update and reconcile the COAH Trust Fund entries. Approval was given on motion made by Mr. Kuhn, seconded by Mr. DeCarolis. All were in favor.

BUDGET:

The salaries were discussed. The Committee approved a 2% increase across the board on motion made by Mr. Desiderio, seconded by Mr. Kuhn. All were in favor with Mr. Desiderio abstaining. The ordinance will be introduced at the February meeting.

Each line item on the worksheet given by Mrs. Maronpot was reviewed and will be further discussed next week.
