MINUTES OF MEETING OF JANUARY 23, 2013

ROLL CALL:

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Boynton asked if Committeemen Desiderio and DeCarolis would meet with surveyor Laura Brill in order for her to give a cost for the metes and bounds on the 9 acres being cut off from the 59 acre parcel. The Clerk will set up.

The Clerk was asked to contact the county and ask about the sign that was on Route 612 that welcomed everyone to Frelinghuysen Township.

Two new policies were considered but not finalized. The first will have each employee who is paid mileage is to submit a detailed mileage breakdown. This will include the destination, the mileage to the destination from the Municipal Building and mileage back to the Municipal Building. The second is a policy that if the township pays for their certification they must stay on the job for 5 years.

BUDGET:

Motion was made by Desiderio, seconded by Stracco to give all the employees a 1% increase. All were in favor.

The Committee went over each position on the salary ordinance and the amounts to be paid. The salary ordinance will be introduced at the February meeting.
