Old Business:

Frank advised that an additional \$10,000 was budgeted for a generator for the rec center totalling \$20,000.00. Dale will install. Frank is also getting a quote for air conditioning.

With regard to the Recreation Center:

We will be reducing the rates for Tai Chi, who use the building one day a week and Karate who use the building two days a week as they are not using the building very much. Motion was made by Todd, seconded by Al to charge \$70.00. The new form will state a maximum use of two days.

Frank & Todd having been working on the kitchen hood. James got another hood but it didn't fit, so it will be sold. The cost will for another hood will be \$1000.00 for an ansele and \$600.00 for a regular hood.

We will need wheels for the stove in order to roll it out to clean behind it. Frank & Todd will talk to Cliff about putting a lock out line for the gas.

The town approved the new exit driveway which will be located on the flat part for visibility and will be a one way.

Erecting a 4x8 sign for the center will be handled by Frank & Keith.

There is a challenging issue with baseball. Keith & Brian are working on it.

New Business:

There is now a projector at the center for movie night. This will be held on Feb. 23rd.

Keith thought it would be a good idea for each sport to make an outline of what is entailed as the coordinator.

Todd would like to do a softball tournament for a fundraiser and charge \$500.00 for each team that enters. He would like to do this on April 14th & 15th. We will provide the umpires, balls and trophies.

A volleyball court will cost \$1600.00 and will be further discussed.

The Easter Egg Hunt was scheduled for March 24th and will be discussed next month.
