Mr. Bruce Barbour appeared before the Commission as a guest speaker. He is a professor emeritus of Agricultural Ecology at Rutgers University. He is a member of the Technical Advisory Committee for the NJ Invasive Species Strike Team.

He discussed setting priorities for, and ways to deal with, local invasive plant species. Specific discussion centered on the property known as the Frelinghuysen Forest Preserve. A potential project for building an enclosure to encourage survival of native plant species was addressed. Future action will include identifying a location at the forest preserve to establish the enclosure. Mr. Barbour has agreed to help us find a suitable site.
