MINUTES OF MEETING OF FEBRUARY 25, 2009

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Durling presented a letter to the Committee for approval to send to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for a required TLC-NJ "sign on" letter. Approval was given.

Mayor Durling presented a copy of a letter from engineer Paul Sterbenz with regard to Saddle Ridge Road. The Committee will review the letter and make comments.

The funds for the ballfield was discussed. Motion was made by Boynton, seconded by DeCarolis to authorize Deputy Mayor Desiderio to apply to the Warren County Soil Conservation District for approval to smooth and re-plant the 5 acres of the Recreational Complex. The salary ordinance was discussed and a 3% increase for all employees was given. (See ordinances) on motion made by Boynton, seconded by DeCarolis. All in favor. Motion was then made by Boynton, seconded by DeCarolis to amend the ordinance to not have an increase for the Mayor and Committee members. All in favor.
