April 3, 2006 Regularly Scheduled Meeting - after discussion, the Minutes of the April 3, 2006 Regularly Scheduled Meeting will be held for comment by Mr. Lavery.

May 1, 2006 Regularly Scheduled Meeting - Approved with minor corrections by a motion made by Ms. Randolph, seconded by Mr. Kuhn, with Mr. Young Abstaining. All other members present were in favor of approving the Minutes.

DISCUSSION - DEEDS and RESOLUTIONS

There were no Deeds or Resolutions for review.

DISCUSSION - FINAL HEARING

Smith, Emily & Lyle - App. #04-16 - Block 701, Lot 15 - Minor Subdivision. Extension granted by Applicant which will expire on July 30, 2006. Qualifying Plan submitted to Board.

DISCUSSION - COMPLETENESS

Riviello, Ruth - App. #05-11 - Block 1703, Lots 5, 10 & 14 and Block 1802, Lots 1, 2, & 6. - Major Subdivision. Original Conceptual Application submitted on October 28, 2005.

Mr. Golden stated the Qualifying Map does not take into account the 300' buffer, a 150' buffer is included, however it needs to be 300' for the endangered species. This needs to be on the Qualifying Map, then density transfer can be used. Applicant asked to have the 300' buffer waived, . Mr. Golden stated that in addition to this buffer, the Applicant sh0ould apply to Fish & Wildlife as well as applying for a LOI.

There was discussion regarding the activity going on the property, heavy machinery is being used. The Zoning Official will be asked to visit the property at his earliest convenience.

Hanula, Joseph - App. #06-04 - Block 103, Lot 11.01 & 11.12 - Lot Line Adjustment/Minor Subdivision.

Mr. Golden referred to the engineering report. Mr. Golden stated the applicant is creating one new lot, 11.02; the applicant is keeping lot 11 and 11.01. Lot 12 will no longer be. Mr. Golden recommended the Board ask the applicant if the property is going to be Deed restricted.

DISCUSSION - CONCEPTUAL/MINOR

Marksboro Presbyterian Church - App. 06-05 - Block 402, Lot 5 - Lot Line Adjustment - Representatives of the Church will be at the meeting on Monday, June 5, 2006, along with Laura Brill, who will be representing them. There was discussion regarding the driveway and the need for a Variance. The Applicant will then have to notify.

Fries, Daniel - App. #06-06 - Block 1801, Lot(s) 10, 10.01 & 10.03 - Site Plan - to be carried to Monday, June 5, 2006 Meeting.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

COAH - Alan DeCarolis, Chair - Mr. DeCarolis stated the committee met briefly, and are in the process of scheduling a meeting with the Deputy Mayor from Oxford Township, as they just developed their COAH plan. More information to follow.

The Secretary, as well as Mr. Boynton, indicated they would not be attending the Meeting. After further discussion, the Board decided to keep the meeting as it is scheduled now.
